Teen Driver Safety

- In early 2006, an alliance was formed between State Farm and The Children's
 Hospital of Philadelphia. Together they conducted the first <u>National Young Driver</u>
 <u>Survey</u> to learn about students' perceptions and experiences surrounding teen
 driving.
 - <u>Driving: Through the Eyes of Teens The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and State Farm®</u>
- State Farm and Illinois State University are collaborating on a two-year project to develop a VR driving simulator to help improve teen driver safety. The project, executed in two phases, involves creating a VR prototype with a steering wheel and foot pedals that immerse users in realistic driving conditions, such as heavy traffic and unexpected obstacles. High school students tested the prototype and provided feedback. The initiative aims to validate the system and help ensure simulated driving translates to real-world performance.
